## What is a tribute painting?

A painting hung in Clovernook's main building in honor or memory of a loved one.

- Each painting will be created by one of Clovernook's artists who is blind or visually impaired.
- Beneath each painting will be a 6" X 8" plaque with the name of the person being honored or memorialized, as well as the name of the artist who created the piece. (Plaques will be engraved in braille as well as text.)
- As a donor, you are investing in a spot on Clovernook's wall for the painting to be hung. The painting will be offered to you as a gift once it has hung on our walls for seven years.



## What are the benefits of purchasing a tribute painting?

### What are the benefits to you as a donor?

- A unique and meaningful tribute to a person who is important to you.
- An opportunity for your loved one to be remembered on a daily basis as Clovernook's employees, consumers and visitors see (or feel) the tribute painting, which may be textured, tactile or three dimensional.
- The chance to give back to an organization which was, or still is, important to your loved one.
- The opportunity to directly support an artist who will receive a fee for their work.
- A contribution which will enlighten the halls of Clovernook.
- Tax deductibility.

### What are the benefits to the artist?

- The chance to express themselves artistically.
- An opportunity to get to know individuals they never met (by creating a painting in someone's honor or memory as well as meeting you the donor).
- Compensation for their time, talent and creativity (the artist keeps roughly 35% off the price).
- The chance to give back to Clovernook, and the donor, by creating a painting, which will be enjoyed by Clovernook's employees and visitors.
- The chance to showcase their talent in the main building (which is frequented more often than Procter Center – the location of The Willoughby Art Gallery).
